9. Presentation of the project logo and website: EU visibility guidelines

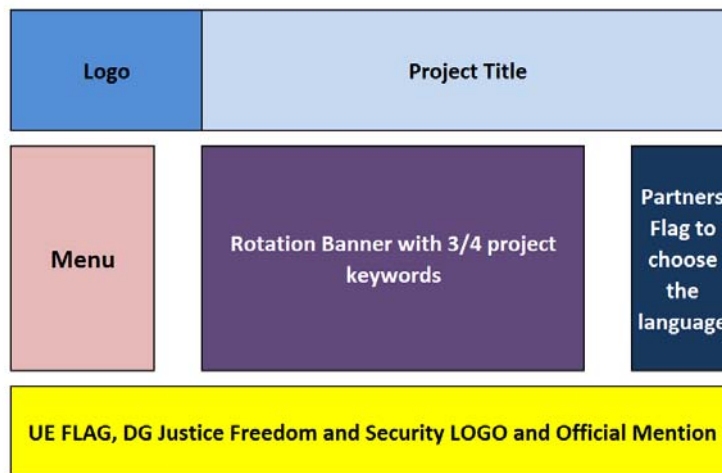
